

I&B PRESENTS THE HISTORICAL PAINTING "LA PASSIONE DELL'ARBITRO", THE FIRST PAINTING IN ART HISTORY TO CELEBRATE THE FIGURE OF THE REFEREE

Milan, September 11th, 2024 | Innova et Bella presents for the first time to the public the historic painting *La Passione dell'Arbitro* by Raffaele Collina (Faenza, 1899 - Campo Ligure 1968).

The work , which can be dated to the first half of the last century, celebrates in a successful allegorical composition, the passion of the referee. In the pictorial composition, centered on the sporting sacrifice of the referee, all the players in

the game of football are masterfully portrayed: the Public, the Supporters, the Players, the Managers, the Journalists, and the Policemen.

The image is dynamic and vibrant, light and shadow give depth and realism to the entire scene, capturing the referee's professional passion in the inevitable fate of eternal public contestation.

The subject, depicted here for the first time in the history of art, makes this painting a unique work of great historical and artistic value, both for its remarkable execution and its connection to the artist's life.

Raffaele Collina, a great painter and football enthusiast, tragically passed away after a sudden illness in the stands of a playing field while cheering for his beloved football team, Vado F.C. 1913, the historic winner of the first edition of the Coppa Italia in 1922.

The historical painting *La Passione dell'Arbitro*, which has recently been conservatively restored at Carlotta Beccaria's fine art restoration studio, is now available to Media, Sports Organizations, and Museums that wish to exhibit it to the public.

Francesco Guido Bonetti, President of Innova et Bella, said: "We are pleased to offer the historical painting La Passione dell'Arbitro to Media, Institutions, and Organizations that wish to expose it to art and sports enthusiasts during their events and exhibitions.
